You would be proud of your fellow members who have been doing volunteer work for other organizations, church or community during this Pandemic. Christ Child Tucson Members have been valuable in our communities.



Angela Schneider has been making Scrub Hats for local hospitals and masks for local churches. She noted that they made 800 in three weeks. Jim Galloway at the Highlands at Dove Mountain shared how



pleased the community was: "Thank you to all the women behind this successful hat project, this was definitely a community effort that came together for the purpose of doing a small part to keep frontline healthcare heads covered. Thank you to all the nurses, physicians, techs, housekeepers!" Angela also makes masks for Oro Valley Church of the Nazarene.

Vita Balsino shared that she has been doing quite a bit of spiritual counseling on the phone for people that live alone. These men and women over 60 are afraid of catching the virus. Their only recreation has been going to bingo, the movies or meeting friends for coffee. They have been feeling hopeless.




